2.	Councillors to declare pecuniary interests: None	
3.	Public Participation (15 minutes):  Bus Service: From 1st August there will be a regular hourly service between Saffron Walden and Dunmow, 2 hourly service calling in at Carver Barracks and Wimbish (alternately).  Some changes need to be made to make the bus service to improve the service more.  There are concerns about what is going to happen to the DART buses after 1st August.  The PC will write to ECC supporting the proposals made by David Corke. The ECC proposals are a big improvement but for no cost it could be made better. Cllr Foley will back the letter from the PC to ECC.  Lucy May field: David Corke is pleased that the fence is going to be removed.  Parking on Elder Street: The public park on the layby next to the large ECC chippings store to walk to Rowney Wood and there is only parking for 5-6 cars. 5.	District Councillor and County Councillor Report: County Councillor: Report sent. Precept levels 4.49 % increase which includes a social care increase. ECC didn't increase the precept last year. Cllr Foley is Chairman of the Youth Strategy and there is a dramatic decrease in youth funding. Have there been an identifiable issue in young people taking drugs in Wimbish? Information to be shared if known. County lines are an issue in the area. Potholes have been taken to the highest levels but some holes are not mended. District Councillor: UDC have balanced their budget which has been approved.	

The planning department is in special measures: The time period for consultation has been reduced to 3 week consultation. UDC will lose money.

UDC corporate plan has been confirmed.
